Tour Descriptions for Cartagena, Colombia

EXPLORING MAGNIFICENT CARTAGENA

Cartagena, Colombia Tour Code: CTG_01

Explore and discover the magnificent city of Cartagena. Begin with a stop at La Popa Monastery, built during the 17th century and dedicated to Nuestra Senora de la Candelaria, patron saint of Cartagena and a colonial museum. Visit a small chapel to see the famous wooden statue of the Virgin, and marvel at the wonderful gold leaf laminated main altar. Continue to San Felipe de Barajas situated outside the walled city for a panoramic view of this monumental fort considered to be the most outstanding feat of Spanish military engineering in the New World.

Continue to Las Bovedas Artisan Center, built as dungeons and as a means of storage. Walk through narrow cobblestone streets and squares inside the walled city. Wander through Plaza de Bolivar which features a statue of its namesake. Visit the Inquisition Palace, established in the year 1610 to punish any crimes against the Catholic faith. You'll see samples of jails and torture chambers. Next, visit the San Pedro Claver cloister and monastery built in homage to the protector of slaves. Before returning to your ship, take home some souvenirs from the Pierino Gallo shopping center and enjoy panoramic sightseeing through Bocagrande, the modern part of the city.

Note: Casual clothes and comfortable shoes are recommended. Wear sunscreen and bring your camera.

HIGHLIGHTS OF CARTAGENA & FOLKLORIC SHOW

Cartagena, Colombia Tour Code: CTG_02

Start your tour of the beautiful city of Cartagena with a photo stop at San Felipe de Barajas Fortress, situated outside the walled city and considered the largest Spanish fort in the New World. Continue to the Old City and wander through narrow cobblestone streets and squares while you admire the Colonial architecture, balconies and old churches. Your next stop will be the Gold Museum where you'll see beautiful displays of valuable pre-Colombian gold artifacts and some of the old ceramics in the Americas.

You'll also learn about the Zenu nation's amazing hydraulic engineering achievements. Enjoy a folkloric show during your visit to the Navy Museum which was established in 1986. Here, you'll find historic military efforts of Cartagena, see the wealth of historical artifacts, maritime life and naval history of Colombia. A bottle of water or soft drink will be served upon arrival at the museum. Before returning to your ship, enjoy panoramic sightseeing through Bocagrande, the modern part of the city.

Note: Casual clothes and comfortable shoes are recommended. Wear sunscreen and bring your camera.

DISCOVER COLOMBIA

Cartagena, Colombia Tour Code: CTG_15

Your day of discovery begins when you board your air conditioned transportation. You'll pass by buildings and homes featuring Colonial, Republican and Moorish styles and your guide explains the many influences that came to be in Cartagena. Your first stop will be 'Punta Icacos', near the fishing village of La Boquilla. Here, you'll be greeted by local fishermen who earn a living by traditional means of fishing. These fishermen will explain the process of making, repairing and casting the nets, as well as provide a demonstration. You'll even have the opportunity to learn the art of throwing the net if you wish or you can also sip on fresh coconut milk or coconut water while you watch your companions cast the net. On your way back to Cartagena your guide will provide you with more information regarding Colombian history including the "Vallenato". The Vallenato is a traditional type of music typically using an accordion, flute and drum. Next, stop at Rancho Grande where you'll be greeted and entertained by your own band of Vallenato.

Sample a traditional Colombian snack or "frito" if you wish before making your way to the Emerald Museum. Here, you'll see craftsmen at work as well as learn the history and cultural importance of the precious stone. Then, visit the famous walled or Old City and Portal de Dulce, an area where local vendors sell the handmade Colombian candies, famous around the world. Take a sweet sample before continuing your walk through the Plaza de la Aduana and Simon Bolivar Square. Along the way your guide will point out areas of interest as well as information on the many churches, buildings and monuments before you begin your free time in the colonial city. Feel free to stroll along the beautiful streets, browse the many shops and admire the beautiful architecture and flower covered balconies before returning to your ship.

Note: Bring comfortable shoes and casual clothes. Wear sunscreen. Participants must be able to stand and walk unassisted as well as easily navigate narrow pathways. The roads to the village can be bumpy.

OLD CITY & SPANISH FORTRESS

Cartagena, Colombia Tour Code: CTG_20

Explore the city of Cartagena with its colonial architecture and impressive fortifications. Pass by the famous Republican architecture of Manga residential area, home to some of the most ornate mansions and homes of the city. Visit the Fort of San Felipe de Barajas built in the 17th century and the largest and most important work of Spanish military engineering in South America. You'll stop briefly at Las Bovedas Artisan Center, originally built as dungeons and for storage - today local artisans display their work here. You'll have some free time to wander the narrow cobblestone streets and squares inside the walled city. Stop at Plaza de Bolivar which features a statue of

its namesake. Across the street is the Inquisition Palace, the Inquisition was established in Cartagena in the year 1610 to punish any crimes against the Catholic faith.

During your visit, you'll see samples of jails and torture chambers. The sentencing ceremony used to take place in public, in the middle of the plaza. On the second floor of the Inquisition Palace there is a small historical museum which includes a few models showing the urban evolution of the city as the centuries passed and the city grew. Continue to the Gold Museum where you'll see beautiful displays of valuable pre-Colombian gold artifacts and some of the old ceramics in the Americas. Learn about the Zenu's nation's amazing hydraulic engineering achievements. Enjoy a panoramic view of the Cathedral while you walk to the majestic San Pedro Claver's Sanctuary built to honor the missionary, who was patron saint of slaves. Sit back and take in the views of the modern city during the return drive to your ship.

Note: This tour involves walking or standing for extended periods of time on some uneven ground and inclines. Tour is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties.

COLONIAL CARTAGENA

Cartagena, Colombia Tour Code: CTG_04

Begin your tour with a panoramic view of the military fort of San Felipe de Barajas. Situated outside the walled city, this monumental fort is considered to be the most outstanding feat of Spanish military engineering in the New World. Continue to the El Cabrero neighborhood for a visit to the Rafael Nunez House and Museum. Rafael Nunez was president of Colombia four times and created the constitution of 1886. The house where he lived and died is built in the spectacular Antilles architectural style.

Next, visit the dungeons within the walled city ramparts, which were built to store provisions for the troops and are now home to a high quality handicrafts market selling brightly decorated cloth, woodwork and woven bags made by some of the indigenous peoples of Colombia. Your tour continues to the Palace of Inquisition. The aim of the Inquisition was to judge crimes against the Catholic faith, but it never recognized anyone's innocence. This building whose construction was finished in 1776 is an example of civilian architecture of the 18th century.

Walk to the Plaza Bolivar where you'll visit the Gold Museum which houses a complete and beautiful archeological display of the pre-Colombian cultures and the fabled El Dorado. You'll have some spare time for shopping in the old city for the famous Colombian emeralds or an opportunity to take more pictures of this lovely city.

SAN FELIPE FORTRESS & CITY AT LEISURE

Visit the largest Spanish fort in the New World – San Felipe de Barajas built in the 17th century and discover the charm of colonial Cartagena with free time to explore on your own. Admire the Republican architecture of La Manga residential area, home to some of the most ornate mansions and beautifully sculpted homes of the city. Continue on with your journey for a 40 minute visit to San Felipe de Barajas.

A short drive will take you to the walled city where you will enjoy a guided walking tour as well as some time on your own. Marvel at the abundance of colonial buildings and fortifications around every corner, as well as the old church domes, the clock tower and the dazzling ocean views.

At La Marina Park, you'll be dropped off to explore the beauty of the Old City on your own. Walk the narrow streets and old plazas, browse the selection of handicrafts, leather goods or emeralds. During your return drive to the ship, enjoy the sights of the modern residential areas of Bocagrande and Castillo Grande.

Note: Amount of walking is at participant's discretion. Walking is on uneven ground, cobblestone streets and some inclines. You'll have a total of 2 hours in the old city. This tour is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties or in a wheelchair.

CITY VIEWS WITH CARRIAGE RIDE

Your tour begins with a drive to the Fort of San Felipe de Barajas, a 17th-century construction and one of the most important works of Spanish Military engineering in Latin America, for a photo stop. Admire the majesty of this historic city, where age-old squares are surrounded by towering colonial, Republican and Spanish-style buildings.

You'll transfer to your waiting horse and carriage and be transported back in time to the days of the conquistadors on a ride around Cartagena's beautiful old town. You'll ride along the inviting, narrow cobblestone streets and through squares inside the walled city, admiring the flower-filled balconies spilling from colonial mansions.

Visit Las Bovedas, the former city dungeons which have also been used as military barracks, a munitions depot and a jail, but today local artisans display their work there. You'll have 30 minutes for shopping before enjoying a panoramic drive through the modern side of the city on your way back to your ship.

Note: Participants must be able to negotiate two large steps to get on in and out of the horse carriage. This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility.

Begin your journey escorted by a professional photographer and a guide. Take a ride to Marlinda, a small fisherman's village and a living example of the roots of the afro culture that populated Cartagena de Indias. Take a sneak peek at the process of canoe making, enjoy the animated spirit of the people and their culture rich with joyful music and dance.

Continue to Old Cartagena and immerse yourself in a world of another era – in the midst of 480 years of history. Beautiful wood balconies full of flowers, colonial houses with their facades still true to their 17th century construction. Visit the majestic San Pedro Claver Church and discover the history of this Jesuit missionary and patron saint of slaves. Before returning to your ship, admire the contrast between the historical and the modern areas of this city.

Note: Walking is on uneven ground, cobblestone streets and sandy beach. This tour is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties or in a wheelchair.

SCENIC CARTAGENA

Cartagena, Colombia Tour Code: CTG_17

Take a panoramic tour of Cartagena. Begin with a photo stop of San Felipe de Barajas Fortress, originally built in the 17th century and considered the largest Spanish fort in the New World. Snap pictures of the ancient towering walls and main entrance. Then, drive by the Old City where your guide will point out historical facts about the Inquisition Palace, the Cathedral and its dome churches.

Your next stop will be Las Bovedas, built in the late 18th century as dungeons and as a means of storage. Continue your journey for a sightseeing tour of the modern residential area of Bocagrande, famous for its wide variety of hotels and restaurants. Here, you'll have the option to stay in the city, visit Pierino Gallo Mall, or return back to the ship on your own.

Note: This is a panoramic tour with optional photo stops. Only collapsible/foldable wheelchairs are welcomed.

Transportation does not have a lift and cannot accommodate scooters. Participants must be able to negotiate two to three steps up into the transportation. Please visit the on board Shore Excursion Desk for more details. You have the option to return to the ship either with the tour or on your own.

The tour narrates the historic secrets that the city walls, buildings and narrow cobbled streets guard. You have the flexibility to plan your time in Cartagena for shopping, sightseeing or just exploring this city at your own pace by hopping- on and off where you wish to.

Enjoy the panoramic views of the Clock Tower that serves as main entrance to the city, the San Felipe Castle, a fortress built in 1536 and other iconic places enriched with history, from your open top double or single decker bus. Stops include La Bodeguita Pier, San Sebastian de Pastelillo, Casa de Rafael Nunez, Bahia Castillo Grande and the Naval Base among others. Also, experience the city on an included walking tour. See the Plaza de San Pedro Claver, Las Bovedas dungeons, Santo Domingo Square and other iconic places enriched with history.

Note: Walking is at guest's discretion. It is recommended that you wear comfortable shoes and bring a hat, sunglasses and sunscreen. Depart the pier to La Popa Monastery, located on top of a hill overlooking Cartagena. This monastery was built at the beginning of the 17th century and houses a Colonial museum and a chapel dedicated to Virgen de la Candelaria, patron saint of Cartagena. Next, make a photo stop at San Felipe Fortress. This castle defended the city from many attacks and withstood the bloodiest assault from the British Admiral Vernon. Proceed to the Old City where you'll walk approximately five blocks through the Colonial section. Once at Bolivar Plaza, you'll find Saint Peter Claver Church, the cathedral and the Inquisition Palace.

After your walk, drive through the modern part of the city to Pierino Gallo Plaza for refreshments and some shopping. Then you'll visit Pastelillo Fort, constructed in the mid 1700's. This is home to one of the most exclusive restaurants in town, Club de Pesca. Located in a corner of the 300 year old fortress, the restaurant overlooks Cartagena's marina and has a view of the walled city. At this elegant setting, take in the surroundings while enjoying a delicious Caribbean appetizer with a contemporary touch.

Drive to the walled city, full of colonial buildings and fortifications. View the old church domes and the clock tower, symbol of the city.

Continue your journey to the Navy Museum established in 1986, restored ruins of the Jesuits school, discover the historic military efforts of Cartagena, peruse through the wealth of historical artifacts, maritime life and naval history of Colombia. Also, enjoy a folkloric show and a refreshing bottle of water. After cooling down, board your bus again to see the sights of the modern residential area of Bocagrande, which in contrast to the old city is modern with high rise apartment complexes, hotels and restaurants. You'll enjoy beautiful views of the bay before returning to your ship.

Pass through the famous "Republican" architecture of Manga residential area, home to some of the most ornate mansions and homes of the city. Continue your journey to one of the most important works of Spanish Military engineering in South America - Fort of San Felipe de Barajas for a photo stop. Wander the narrow cobblestone streets and squares inside the walled city. Beginning at Santo Domingo's Bastion, you'll pass by charming colonial architecture to the oldest church in the city - Church of Santo

Domingo. Continue walking to Plaza de Bolivar, a picturesque tree lined square adorned with statues saluting the city's illustrious past and features a statue of its namesake. Across the street, see the Inquisition Palace.

Then, make your way to the Gold Museum where you'll find beautiful displays of valuable pre-Colombian gold artifacts and some of the old ceramics in the Americas. Learn about the Zenu's nation's hydraulic engineering achievements. Continue to the colonial commercial district of Custom Plaza and down the street to the Cathedral and the Governor's house, headquarters of the Spanish government. Stroll to Plaza San Pedro to see the shrine and church honoring Saint Peter Claver, the patron saint of slaves. Soak up the local flavor as you continue your guided walk amidst towering colonial, republican and Spanish-style buildings and surrender to the majesty of this historic city. Do some shopping at Las Bovedas Artisan Center, built as dungeons, today local artisans display their work here. On the way back to your ship, enjoy a sightseeing tour through the modern part of Cartagena.

Note: This tour includes extended periods of walking or standing, it's not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Walking is on level ground and cobblestone streets. Some venues have a second floor (Inquisition Palace, Gold Museum).

You'll also have the opportunity to try some of the moves that you've seen.

Continue on to the walled colonial city for a guided walking tour. You'll be provided a brief overview and a map and your guide will lead you through the Main Plaza, Customs Plaza and Simon Bolivar Square. You'll then have an hour and a half of free time to explore this incredible city with its many cafes, art, bars and shops on your own. Stop at a museum, enjoy a cup of Colombian coffee or stroll along the beautiful streets as you admire the flower filled balconies and remarkable architecture. At the previously designated time and place, you'll rejoin your group for the transportation back to your ship.

Note: There is approximately one hour of walking or standing. Participants should be able to stand and walk unassisted and easily navigate uneven terrain and narrow pathways. This tour is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties or in a wheelchair.

Meet new people, enjoy live music and take part in the open bar while your Chiva takes you around Cartagena. You'll make a photo stop at San Felipe Fortress, Manga, Pie de la Popa, El Centro, Boca Grande, Laguito, Castillo Grande, and the old city. Your Chiva will stop at the historic Santa Catalina's Bastion. Here you can stretch, enjoy refreshments, dance to the beat of the music band or enjoy local entertainment. You'll have some time for souvenir and handicraft shopping at Las Bovedas Artisan Center.

Note: Chiva buses are old artisan modified buses used in rural areas for public transport. They are painted colorfully with local arabesques and figures. Most of the chivas have an incorporated ladder for the rack on the roof which is also used for carrying people; seats are bench like, made out of wood and with doors instead of windows and all of them have a unique nickname. Wear comfortable shoes and casual clothes, bring a camera and sunscreen.

You'll visit the Cueva del Manglar, a protected eco-system that's teeming with birdlife.

Embark on a leisurely canoe ride through the mangrove tunnels. As you glide through the swamp waters, keep your eyes open for a diversity of birds such as kingfisher, white heron, common Laura, pink spatula and pelicans. Relax as you enjoy the beautiful flora and fauna that encompasses this fascinating eco-system. Enjoy a panoramic tour of the old city of Cartagena on the drive back to your ship.

Note: Wear comfortable clothing and shoes, bring sunscreen and a hat. Guests do not paddle the canoes.
