Tour Descriptions for Hilo, Hawaii

VOLCANO & RAINBOW FALLS

Hilo, Hawaii Tour Code: ITO_03

You'll begin just outside Hilo at Rainbow Falls, an 80-foot cascade that plunges into a circular pool, creating rainbows in the resulting mist. Hilo is considered one of the world's orchid capitals, and Akatsuka Gardens is the perfect place to appreciate these tropical beauties that come in a stunning assortment of shapes, sizes, colors and patterns.

A one-hour drive transports you to a very different scene in Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, where 70 million years of volcanic history are on display. Admire the remarkable view of Kilauea, the world's most active volcano. Learn about the birth of the still growing Hawaiian Islands at the Jaggar Museum where you'll view the Halemaumau Crater – in Hawaiian mythology said to be home to Pele, Goddess of Fire and Volcanoes.

You'll also have the opportunity to walk through the extinct Thurston Lava Tube, a cave formed by a river of lava. A visit to the Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory completes your tour. A boxed lunch will be provided.

Note: Please be advised that while at Volcanoes National Park, you won't see molten lava, but may encounter natural sulfur gases that can affect those with respiratory problems. Thurston Lava Tube is not wheelchair accessible due to uneven pathways and steps. An additional optional shopping stop may be made.

VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK

Hilo, Hawaii Tour Code: ITO_01

Explore Volcanoes National Park, home to Kilauea, the most active volcano in the world. Learn how volcanic events have impacted the landscape and the lives of the people that live here.

A one-hour drive transports you to Volcanoes National Park, where 70 million years of volcanic history are on display. At just over 4,000 feet, Kilauea is not the tallest volcano on the Big Island, but as the world's most active one, it leaves a large lava footprint. Drive along the crater's rim for views of this dramatic landscape.

Learn about the birth of the still growing Hawaiian Islands at the Jaggar Museum, where you'll view the Halemaumau Crater – in Hawaiian mythology said to be home to Pele, Goddess of Fire and Volcanoes. You'll also have the opportunity to walk through the extinct Thurston Lava Tube, a cave formed by a river of lava. End your day with a visit to Big Island Candies.

Note: Please be advised that while at Volcanoes National Park, you may encounter natural sulfur gases, which

can affect those with respiratory problems, and you won't see molten lava. Thurston Lava Tube is not wheelchair accessible due to uneven pathways and steps. An additional optional shopping stop may be provided.

THE LAND OF FROZEN FIRE

Hilo, Hawaii Tour Code: ITO_21

Head first to the small, off-the-beaten-path town of Pahoa with its inviting boardwalk. Nearby is Lava Tree State Park, a once lush rainforest that happened to be in the path of a lava flow. The trees burned from the inside out, leaving hollow stone skeletons. Now covered with moss, they make for an eerie panorama.

Visit Ahalanui's volcanically heated warm springs. Along the way and during brief stops, view the striking scenery that results when lava meets the sea – cliffs, lava tubes, and blowholes. Perhaps you'll be lucky enough to see a blowhole spouting water high in the air.

The small fishing village of Kalapana and Kaimu the site of the original black sand beach were both destroyed by a 1990 lava flow. Take a walk on this "frozen fire" and get a look at the active volcanic vent in the distance. Chat with a survivor of the eruption and view a photo exhibit of the area you just walked through to see how it looked before buried in 1990.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age, able to walk short distances unaided and wear closed-toe shoes.

SECRETS OF PUNA

Hilo, Hawaii Tour Code: ITO_27

On this deluxe tour to the Kilauea volcano, you'll see how its eruptions have changed the life and landscape of the Big Island, devouring villages and forests, and extending the island's shoreline. Learn how the residents cope, and how dedicated they are to saving what is precious from the onslaught of molten rock.

The lush greenery of Hilo gives way to stark black rock in Kalapana, a village completely destroyed by advancing lava in 1990. Your first stop is the lovely Painted Church. Now decommissioned, it was moved by determined villagers not once but twice, to evade the oncoming flow. You'll see how the volcano engulfed everything in its path, completely filling in Kaimu Bay, and covering what was the best swimming beach on the island. Fortunately nature has provided a replacement – walk across now hardened stone to the new black sand beach.

Continue along the scenic Puna coastline to the jagged lava cliffs of MacKenzie State Park. Your guide knows the location of a volcanically heated cove where you can take a dip or snorkel among tropical fish and the occasional giant green sea turtle. You'll also visit Lava Tree State Park, once a rainforest that happened to be in the path of a lava flow. The trees burned from the inside out, leaving hollow stone skeletons. Now covered with moss, they make for an eerie panorama.

A Hawaiian-style barbecue lunch, which includes complimentary beer and Champagne, is included. There are opportunities to purchase local products and souvenirs along the way.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age. Tour capacity is limited and the order of the itinerary may change. Molten lava will not be seen. Wear comfortable closed-toe shoes and bring a swimsuit and towel. Special dietary needs can be accommodated with advance notice.

KILAUEA 2 WAYS

You'll see how the volcano engulfed everything in its path, completely filling in Kaimu Bay and covering what was the best swimming beach on the island. Fortunately nature has provided a replacement – walk across now hardened rock to the new, beautiful black sand beach. Travel along the scenic Puna coastline to where the jagged 40-foot lava cliffs of MacKenzie State Park meet the Pacific Ocean for an amazing view.

Explore Lava Tree State Park, a rainforest that happened to be in the path of a lava flow. The trees burned from the inside out, leaving hollow stone skeletons. Now covered with moss, they make for an eerie panorama.

Note: If you have any back problems, existing heart conditions, or are pregnant, this tour is not for you. You must wear sturdy closed-toe shoes. The order of the itinerary may change, and molten lava will not be seen.

Picture yourself in a lush, natural paradise. At the Hawaii Tropical Botanical Garden you can wander amidst 2,000 species of fragrant tropical flowers, colorful fruits and plants from all over the world.

The garden features nature trails and is graced with sparkling streams, several waterfalls, and dramatic ocean vistas. The collection includes an extensive assortment of palms – nearly 200 varieties – including a grove of towering Alexandra palms that mimics the hushed atmosphere of a cathedral. The air is filled with the fragrance of tropical flowers and fruits, and is also home to many birds.

All plants are labeled for easy identification. You'll receive a map of the garden's trails at the Visitor Center, and then enjoy your time wandering the grounds at your own pace, taking photographs or just absorbing the natural beauty of this unique place.

VOLCANO & TASTES OF HAWAII

Kilauea's eruptions have changed the life and landscape of the Big Island. But even this destruction has positive side effects. Volcanic ash nourishes the soil, and eventually benefits local agriculture. Combine your exploration of stark volcanic landscapes with tastes of the island's famous coffee and a picnic lunch at an art gallery.

Start your morning right with locally grown and freshly roasted Hawaiian coffee at the famous Hilo Coffee Mill on your way to Volcanoes National Park. Once there, guides will take small groups on short leisurely strolls through luxuriant rainforest alive with native birds and exotic foliage. Ramble through a lava tube, walk across new lava formations, and notice the rebirth of the native rainforest as it slowly recovers from the destructive force of molten stone.

Explore hidden overlooks off the beaten path and witness the explosive power of Halemaumau Crater. Make a stop at the Jaggar Museum with its real time seismographs and eruption footage. Savor a specialty picnic lunch and a complimentary glass of wine on the lush grounds of Volcano Garden Arts, a gallery showcasing Hawaiian artists. No gourmet adventure would be complete without a stop at Big Island Candies, known for their handmade macadamia nut shortbread cookies dipped in chocolate!

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and all children less than 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. You must be at least 21 years of age to consume wine. You'll receive an informative commentary from your tour guide/pilot over an individual headset.

ULTIMATE HELICOPTER & WATERFALL ADVENTURE

Soar over Kilauea on a thrilling helicopter ride, travel by road to a remote location for a barbeque lunch overlooking a private waterfall, and return to Hilo along a stunning scenic route through dense tropical rainforests and past plunging waterfalls. This will definitely be a day to remember.

Board a comfortable, air-conditioned aircraft, and watch as the brilliant green of the forest gives way to stark black lava rock as you approach the volcano. Keep your eyes open for surface flows and lava entering the ocean. Head

north past Hilo, flying over prime rainforest dotted with waterfalls. After landing you'll be met by your guide and head off to enjoy a Hawaiian barbeque lunch overlooking a tumbling waterfall in the middle of the jungle. On your return make a stop for a refreshing swim and a visit to Rainbow Falls, an 80-foot cascade that plunges into a circular pool, creating rainbows in the resulting mist.

CRATER HIKE & AKAKA FALLS

Hilo, Hawaii Tour Code: ITO_13

This is the ideal excursion for experienced hikers. From dramatic black lava flows to lush rainforests and plunging waterfalls, experience the scenic majesty of Hawaii's natural landscape as you explore on foot.

In Volcanoes National Park, you'll stride through a lava tube and trek down into a volcanic crater. The four-mile round-trip hike meanders through forests of trees turned to stone, and passes gaping, steaming fissures where lava once gushed over a thousand feet skyward.

Visit the Jagger Museum, with its real time seismographs, eruption footage, displays of lava and Hawaiian geology, and an overlook on the steaming vent in the Halemaumau Crater. Stop to admire Akaka, one of Hawaii's most impressive waterfalls, dropping 442 feet over green leafy cliffs into a deep pool below.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, experienced hikers, and in good health. The crater hike crosses some rugged sections requiring visual and balance acuity. Switchbacks, stairs, and uneven surfaces will be encountered, as well as highly variable weather patterns.

Infants are not permitted, even if carried by adults. Wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes. Due to natural sulfur gases, this tour is not recommended for those with respiratory or heart problems. A light lunch, water, and ponchos are included. An alternative waterfall may be visited depending on weather conditions.

MAUNA KEA

Hilo, Hawaii Tour Code: ITO_05

Make the journey up to the summit of the dormant Mauna Kea volcano for an exhilarating experience and breathtaking views above the clouds. Your drive starts at sea level and climbs up almost 14,000 feet in two hours. This is the world's tallest mountain, measuring 32,000 feet from its underwater base to its summit at 13,796 feet above sea level.

Due to the dry, cloud-free atmosphere and distance from city lights, it hosts the world's largest astronomical site. Currently there are 13 powerful telescopes here, operated by astronomers from 11 countries.

You'll also stop at the Visitor Information Center in the Onizuka facility at 9,200 feet, so that you can adjust to the altitude. The Center was built to allow astronomers and technicians to acclimatize before beginning their work at the summit.

Note: Participants must be at least 16 years of age. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women, persons suffering from respiratory disorders or heart problems. Oxygen is carried for emergencies and warm parkas are provided, as the weather at the summit may be quite cold. In rare cases where the summit is closed due to sudden storms, an alternate will be provided. A light lunch is included.

Hilo is America's wettest city, so be prepared for plenty of rainbows and a lush tropical coastline. Your excursion will take you along Hilo's shoreline with lovely views of the Wailoa River and Wailuku River estuaries to see some waterfalls. This is where the 18-mile river reaches the ocean. Keep your eyes peeled for a glimpse of the Mauna Kea summit.

Note: Participants must be at least 7 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs. This tour is not recommended for those with back problems or heart conditions. Wear a swimsuit and bring a towel. Tour is weather dependent.

Begin with a scenic drive to the Visitor's Center at Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, where you will collect your bike. The route is mostly level terrain with a couple of small uphill sections. After the ride, hike through a dense rainforest that leads you directly through an amazing lava tube. Other mini hikes will be made to scenic overlooks to observe the heart of the volcano and its most active crater.

Make a stop at the Jaggar Museum with its real time seismographs and eruption footage. Snack on fresh island fruit and macadamia nuts during the tour.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, a minimum of 4'6" in height and know how to ride a bicycle. Please be advised that while at Volcanoes National Park, you may encounter natural sulfur gases, which can affect those with respiratory problems. Bike, helmet, gloves and rain jacket are provided. After your zip line adventure, enjoy a relaxing stroll through the World Botanical Gardens and the soothing view of a cascading waterfall.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age, weigh between 70 and 270 lbs. and must be comfortable with heights. Take your need for speed to new heights on this thrilling zipline adventure. Covering nearly two miles of gorgeous tropical river gorges, this 8-line zip course is fun for the whole family.

The certified staff will guide you over one of the longest lines on the island at more than 2,400 feet. Ride the only all side-by-side dual-track zipline on Hawaii. Elevated platforms connect with exciting features like suspension bridges and suspended staircases.

You'll zoom 160 feet over multiple waterfalls, gaze at panoramic ocean views, and be serenaded by native birdcalls in the forest until they are drowned out by the roar of rapids from the river below. The last line is the longest at more than 1/2 mile. Glide directly down the middle of the river, for an amazing adrenaline rush. A fully narrated off-road adventure gets you to and from the zipline course.

Note: Participants must weigh between 35 and 275 lbs., must be able to lift 15 lbs. and walk up stairs and over uneven terrain. Wear closed toe shoes. If you are pregnant or have had past heart, neck or back problems, this tour is not for you. There will be a charge for guests who want to be observers only, and do the walk but not the zip.

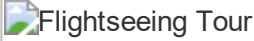
