ROAD TO HANA

Kahului, Maui Tour Code: OGG_07

Sit back and enjoy the sights along the famed Hana Highway without having to navigate the twisting, curving road yourself. With an expert driver at the wheel, you won't miss any of the incredible scenery of lava cliffs, tumbling waterfalls, the rugged northern coastline, lush hillsides of feathery ferns and trees laden with tropical fruits. You'll stop to explore various sites along the way to "Heavenly Hana," in this wonderfully natural and pristine landscape.

Lunch is included before you continue beyond Hana to the Kipahulu District, inhabited by native Hawaiians for hundreds of years. Here you'll have the chance to see and photograph the glistening pools formed by several waterfalls cascading down the side of the Haleakala volcano.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age. This tour is not recommended for those guests who are prone to motion sickness or suffer from back problems, as part of the road traveled is unpaved.

ROAD TO HANA DELUXE

Enjoy pastries and beverages at Paia, where your journey to Hana begins. Then relax and take in the incredible scenery of lava cliffs, tumbling waterfalls, lush hillsides of feathery ferns, and trees laden with tropical fruit. You'll have plenty of photo opportunities and time to explore at a leisurely pace, with many stops made along this spectacular coastal drive.

Investigate the Keanae Peninsula, one of the last enclaves of native Hawaiians. Here tranquil taro fields and Waikani Falls, a cascade of fresh mountain rainwater, are just some of the sights for you to enjoy. It's also the perfect place for you to learn about the native Hawaiian people, their culture and the land they call home.

Lunch is included, and there is time for you to stroll, swim, sunbathe or just relax. You'll see a demonstration of coconut husking and taste luscious tropical fruits. Take time to browse at the gift shop, featuring many Made in Maui items and fresh fruit grown on the plantation.

Explore a lush reef with colorful coral combinations found nowhere else in these islands and home to more than 250 species of fish.

Weather permitting, you'll make a second stop at Turtle Arches where you can swim and snorkel while keeping your eyes open for the Hawaiian green sea turtles that frequent these waters. A continental breakfast, lunch and beverages are included. A shopping stop is included on the return trip.

Check out Maui's massive Haleakala volcano from bottom to top, as you journey from sea level to the summit to view spectacular island scenery and the immense crater of volcanic rock. You can catch a glimpse of Haleakala, Maui's massive dormant volcano, from almost any point on the island, but you will go all the way to the top on this scenic journey – from sea level to 10,000 feet. At the summit is a vast crater seven and a half miles long by two and a half miles wide, and 3,000 feet deep. It last erupted in 1790 and has slumbered ever since, though that does not mean it won't one day wake up. The Hawaiians revere it as a sacred site, and tell tales of Pele, Goddess of Fire and Volcanos.

The views from the top are magnificent. If the day is clear, you may even make out two other towering peaks – Mauna Loa and Mauna Kea on the Big Island. From the crater's rim, you'll be able to appreciate first hand the unique beauty of this imposing caldera with its interesting mix of volcanic rock and plant life, some of which, like the silversword plant, is found only in Hawaii's volcanic craters.

Note: This tour is not recommended for guests with respiratory or heart problems. We recommend you bring a sweater as temperatures range between 40-65 degrees Fahrenheit at the crater's top.

Start your day "on top of the world" – the pinnacle of Haleakala at 10,000 feet. Travel there in an exclusive 8-passenger luxury limo-van, and enjoy a continental breakfast as you await the sun's first rays. First light reveals a palette of glowing pastel hues and a 360-degree view. Once it is light enough you'll marvel at the crater's eerie landscape of cinder cones and ancient lava formations. If the day is clear, you may even make out two other towering peaks – Mauna Loa and Mauna Kea on the Big Island. There are numerous photo opportunities as you descend the mountain.

You'll learn about the native Hawaiian people, their culture and the land they call home, and stop by a protea farm to see these ancient and exotic flowers. There are 1,500 types of protea, 90 of which grow in the cool Maui uplands and on the slopes of Haleakala. Their shapes are spiky and unusual and their colors intense.

RAPPEL WATERFALLS

Kahului, Maui Tour Code: OGG_45

Set off along the famed Hana Highway for a one hour ride to a botanical garden, where you'll gear up and literally "learn the ropes." Then you'll begin your hike into a great canyon lined with 30- and 50-foot waterfalls that plunge into deep pools. Your first rappel is a dry one, down an easy 60-foot slope that starts gently and becomes steeper and steeper, ending with the descent of a vertical rock wall. You can do this rappel as many times as you need to before moving on to the first waterfall.

The hardest part is going over the edge, but once you're airborne, it's just a matter of letting the pull of gravity take over. You'll either walk down the cliffside or sail through the air, depending on the structure of the canyon. Swim in the inviting pools beneath the waterfalls before hiking a 300-foot ascent up a challenging jungle trail. Then enjoy a well-deserved lunch overlooking the valley, with panoramic views of the ocean.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and weigh no more than 250 lbs. They must be in good health and condition, with no fear of heights. Minimum waist size is 22 inches, maximum 54 inches, to fit the harnesses. Bring a swimsuit and a change of clothes.

HANA HALEAKALA HELICOPTER TOUR

Discover Maui's spectacular sights from the air. Begin at the top with Haleakala, Maui's massive volcano. From above you'll get a good feel for the scale of this vast crater seven and a half miles long by two and a half miles wide and 3,000 feet deep. Its terrain is so otherworldly that NASA has used it to simulate the face of the moon.

View the tranquil taro fields of Keanae Valley – one of the last enclaves of native Hawaiians and the rugged coast of East Maui.

Your pilot is also a certified tour guide and will narrate your flight. With two-way communication between pilot and passengers, you are also able to ask questions.
