Tour Descriptions for Dunedin, New Zealand

DUNEDIN PENINSULA – WILDLIFE & LARNACH CASTLE

Dunedin, New Zealand Tour Code: ORR_03

Enjoy a scenic drive past the charming towns along the shores of Otago Harbor and a brief orientation tour of Dunedin, including a drive past the botanical gardens and the historic University of Otago. Arrive at the Royal Albatross Center, get ready to experience the privilege of seeing the huge Albatrosses, with their incredible wing span of nearly 10 feet, glide smoothly and gracefully from the viewing area. You'll learn about their fascinating social and family life. In order to protect the birds' natural habitat and from being overly disturbed, access is controlled.

Stop at Larnach Castle, an impressive stone mansion that was constructed between 1871 and 1885. Set in a park-like setting amidst trees and colorful gardens, the castle boasts many elaborate features, a result of the many English and Italian artisans and craftsmen who worked on the home. A curving hanging staircase, carved ceilings and an array of wonderful antiques on display showcase the castle's exceptional design. Enjoy lunch on the castle grounds and free time to stroll the beautiful property.

Note: Tour involves negotiating many steps and steep inclines. There are no ramps or elevators in the castle. Comfortable walking shoes and a light raincoat are recommended. Tour operates with a driver/guide.

HIGHLIGHTS OF DUNEDIN

Dunedin, New Zealand Tour Code: ORR_02

Dunedin is known for being home to some of the country's most adored Victorian structures, its streets are adorned with a collection of historic buildings, cathedrals and churches. A scenic drive past the charming towns of the shores of Otago Harbor brings you to Olveston. You'll visit the Olveston Historic Home, the original home of a wealthy family that was built between 1904 and 1906. It offers a glimpse into the refined way of life in days past.

Departing from Olveston, you'll pass several historical landmarks including the Gothic revival-styled Otago University, the Law Courts, Otago Boys High School, First Church, and the Edwardian mansions of Royal Terrace and High Streets.

Visit the Dunedin Botanic Garden where the gardens cover some 69 acres and were the first public botanical gardens established in New Zealand. Free time will be provided for you to admire the well-manicured lawns, splashing fountains and statuary and an extensive collection of camellias, annuals and colorful roses. The Winter Garden Glasshouse has a great range of temperate species on display and there is also a substantial rock garden. Feel free to direct any questions to the local guides. Shuttles will be available for those guests who wish to stay

in the city center at the end of the tour.

OTAGO HARBOR WILDLIFE CRUISE

Dunedin, New Zealand Tour Code: ORR_04

It's a short walk from the ship's side to the floating pontoon where your sightseeing vessel stands ready to take you on your cruise around beautiful Otago Harbor. You'll see from a distance the picturesque townships of Carey's Bay, Deborah Bay and Acheron Head as you navigate to Taiaroa Head. Along the way, the Captain will provide commentary about this pristine environment.

From the deck of your boat, you'll have an excellent opportunity for a close-up view of the areas wildlife, which include seals, cormorants, albatross and various other waders. You may even catch sight of penguins and playful dolphins. Alive with wildlife, Taiaroa Head boasts over 10 species of nesting birds amongst its inhabitants, including the Royal Albatross. This stretch of rugged shoreline is also home to a colony of breeding Southern Fur Seals. The evidence of past volcanic activity and early settlement makes for a spectacular and dramatic backdrop to your harbor cruise.

Note: Comfortable, non-slip sole shoes, a warm, water and windproof jacket are recommended. Wildlife sightings are not guaranteed. Tour operates with a driver/guide.

THE TAIERI GORGE RAILWAY EXPERIENCE

Dunedin, New Zealand Tour Code: ORR_01

Hop aboard the Taieri Gorge Railway and discover why the Taieri Gorge is famous for its sheer cliffs and dramatic ravines, as spectacular, breathtaking scenery unfolds before you. Once on board, you'll be greeted by your crew and offered a welcome drink. You'll travel alongside beautiful Otago Harbor before turning inland to suburban Dunedin. Leaving the city behind, your train will pass through the fertile farmland of the Taieri plains before climbing into the Taieri River Gorge. The steep cliff faces and dramatic gaps unfold, revealing a truly breathtaking scenery.

The railroad itself is a true marvel, having been built by early pioneers through some of New Zealand's most rugged terrain, its very existence is considered by many to be a remarkable achievement. Notice the intricate work of the skilled railway gangs, stonemasons and engineers who carved the high bridges and produced the

labyrinth of latticework that supports this historic train route.

Enjoy both a morning tea and lunch aboard the train. The train will wind its way through the gorge, passing one unspoiled panorama after another while navigating through rock tunnels and crossing bridges suspended high above the river below. Stops will be made along the route for you to capture some photos that will surely become memorable keepsakes.
