Tour Descriptions for Bay of Islands, New Zealand

GLOW WORM CAVE & PUKETI KAURI FOREST

Bay of Islands, New Zealand Tour Code: BYO_05

Discover natural wonders, including a cavern filled with glowworms and a forest of mighty Kauri trees that can live 2,000 years and soar more than 150 feet into the air. A short drive brings you to the Kawiti Caves, a wonderland of caverns owned by the descendants of the Maori chieftain Kawiti. While the caves' stalagmites and stalactites are breathtaking, the true highlight is the display of thousands of glowworms illuminating the ceiling from a distance. You'll also notice their unusual, single-string webs hanging from the ceiling to trap small flying insects.

Dive to nearby Kawakawa, New Zealand's only town with a railroad track running down the main street and known for its whimsical public restrooms, designed by an Austrian artist in 1998. They feature cobblestone floors, colorful mosaics and copper handiwork. You'll have some free time here.

You'll visit Puketi Forest, which once covered most of the Bay of Islands. Walking along the boardwalk through the now-protected forest reserve, you'll see a number of impressive Kauri trees, a towering species that rivals California's redwoods in height and girth. The boardwalk allows visitors an up-close look at these magnificent trees while protecting their sensitive roots. Heading back to the pier, you'll travel through historical Kerikeri for a photo-stop opposite the Kemp House, New Zealand's oldest building, and the Stone Store, which was constructed in the 1830s.

Note: This tour includes approximately 90-minutes of easy to moderate walking and 150 steps to negotiate at the caves. The tour is not recommended for those who suffer from claustrophobia. Casual, weather appropriate clothing to include a light jacket or sweater; sun cap; sunglasses; and flat, comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Photography is not permitted in the caves. The visit to Puketi Forest is non-guided.

KAYAKING ON WAITANGI ESTUARY

Bay of Islands, New Zealand Tour Code: BYO_02

Discover the calm waters of the Waitangi Estuary during this scenic kayaking tour. Join your guide at the wharf and walk to your awaiting kayaks. After receiving your safety instructions, your kayaking adventure begins. You'll see an abundance of mangrove trees, and their extensive root systems protruding from beneath the water's surface. These unique trees are the lifeblood of this estuary and a favorite breeding ground for many small fish.

At the end of the estuary, you'll arrive at Haruru Falls, which are surrounded on one side by the Waitangi Forest. Although not especially high, the falls are still an impressive sight, especially after a recent rainfall. Light refreshments will be served at a picnic area near the falls before returning to the Waitangi Wharf.

p>Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and be in good physical condition. While the Waitangi Estuary is normally very calm and well protected, it is recommended that guests have previous kayaking experience. There are approximately 400 yards of walking from Waitangi Wharf to the kayaking center.

Guests have a choice of single or double kayaks, please contact the Shore Excursion Desk onboard and advise them of your preference at least 48 hours in advance. Wear a bathing suit under shorts or a cover-up, beach shoes, a hat and sunglasses, and bring a jacket

KERIKERI & WAITANGI HIGHLIGHTS

Bay of Islands, New Zealand Tour Code: BYO_03

Discover New Zealand's historic Maori and European influences during this scenic journey to Kerikeri and Waitangi. You'll drive to the commercial center of the Bay of Islands and site where one of the earliest missionary stations was established in 1823. Continue on to Kerikeri, where New Zealand missionaries built the first house, Kemp House, and adjacent Stone Store. Today, Kerikeri is now a thriving citrus fruit growing area.

Upon your return to Waitangi, you'll visit the Waitangi Treaty House. It was here that the Maori chiefs signed over sovereignty of their lands to Queen Victoria of Great Britain in 1840. Most of the timber used to build this house, first lived in by British resident and acting Governor James Busby, was brought over from Sydney and later assembled on site.

Your tour will conclude with a stroll through the beautiful grounds of the Treaty House. Along the way, you'll see the impressive Maori meeting place and a ceremonial war canoe.

Note: This tour involves approximately 100 yards to walk to the Kemp House and Stone Store, and about 700 yards of mostly downhill walking at the Waitangi Treaty House and grounds. There are 12 steps in the Stone Store to access the 1st floor. Visit of the Waitangi Treaty House is self- guided.

Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
