AUSSIE WILDLIFE

Sydney, Australia Tour Code: SYD_04

Travel through Sydney's leafy suburbs en route to a unique wildlife experience at Featherdale Wildlife Park. On arrival, one of the personable park guides will introduce you to some of the park's residents. Encounter some of Australia's unique wildlife in a natural bush setting, including birds, reptiles, marsupials, and other mammals. Enjoy some free time to explore this attraction and view the animals and native fauna at your own pace.

Perhaps you'll want to hand feed a kangaroo for a truly memorable and interactive experience. A photo taken with an adorable koala will no doubt serve as a lifelong memento of your visit. Kangaroo feed and Koala photo are available for purchase. Before leaving the Sanctuary, you will be treated to morning tea.

BLUE MOUNTAINS & SYDNEY OVERVIEW

Sydney, Australia Tour Code: SYD_03

As you travel through the city on your way to the mountains, you'll pass the 2000 Olympic site at Homebush. Following the trail of Australia's early explorers, you climb high into the Blue Mountains passing through Olympic Park. Sit back and enjoy the awe-inspiring giant rock formations, geological history, and cascading waterfalls. Your mountain sightseeing takes you through numerous small towns along the way.

Arriving at the Blue Mountains lookout, you'll see the famous rock formation, the Three Sisters and relish amazing panoramic views of the Jamison Valley, Mount Solitary, the Ruined Castle, Katoomba Falls and the Burragorang Valley. Enjoy a ride on the world's steepest perpendicular railway, which plunges 700 feet into the valley offering stunning views. Disembarking at the bottom, it's an approximate 7 minute walk to the Scenic Cableway which returns you to the top of the mountain. Enjoy free time in the charming village of Leura where you'll have the opportunity to grab a bite to eat and to explore some of the local crafts and antique shops and admire the views. You'll also be treated to a brief overview of the Sydney's essential highlights.

CITY SIGHTS & HARBOR CRUISE

Sydney, Australia Tour Code: SYD_10

What better way to explore the most celebrated sights of Sydney than by both land and by sea? Travel back in time to Sydney's oldest village - the Rocks. Australia's most historic enclave sits in the shadow of the Harbor Bridge and exhibits the heritage of two centuries in its narrow twisting streets. You'll have the opportunity to stop for breathtaking views and photos from under the Harbor Bridge. Your route takes you passed historic Paddington, a trendy artists' haven of steep hills and Victorian homes, and then on to the Royal Australian Naval Base at Garden Island. You'll see Sydney's Chinatown, the Opera House and the Sydney Entertainment Center before making your way to Bondi Beach for a photo opportunity. Enjoy more amazing views of the harbor entrance from The Gap, pass through the exclusive suburbs of Double Bay and Vaucluse, and Sydney's 'hot spot', King's Cross.

Change gears as you board a touring vessel for a relaxing and informational cruise of the stunning Sydney Harbor, during which you'll see the magnificent upper reaches of Middle Harbor with its natural parklands, inner harbor beaches, marinas and palatial waterfront homes. This leisurely cruise also takes you past the Opera House, the Harbor Bridge and Fort Denison before returning you to land for a short walking tour around the Sydney Opera House and Circular Quay.

LEISURELY SYDNEY

Sydney, Australia Tour Code: SYD_01

Travel back in time to Sydney's oldest village - the Rocks. Australia's most historic enclave sits in the shadow of the Harbor Bridge and exhibits the heritage of two centuries in its narrow twisting streets. The Victorian era brought prosperity to Sydney and endowed the area with several striking buildings. Today, many of them still remain, nestled amongst the city's modern architecture. As you travel through the city you'll pass by the Sydney Tower, the Queen Victoria building, the Darling Harbor Complex and Chinatown. You'll have the opportunity to see the well-known site referred to as Mrs. Macquarie's Chair, an exposed sandstone rock cut in the shape of a bench which is located on a peninsula of the Sydney Harbor.

You'll see Sydney's most desirable residential areas as you travel from Darling Point to Watson's Bay. Numerous sidewalk cafés and trendy boutiques can be seen in Double Bay, and Watson's Bay offers an outstanding city skyline view. Enjoy a photo stop at Bondi Beach, Australia's world famous surfing beach where both Sydneysiders and tourists alike each come to enjoy the half-mile crescent of sandy beach and the delightful eateries and shops which line the main street.

SYDNEY SIGHTS, OPERA HOUSE & BONDI BEACH

Enjoy a visit to one of Sydney’s icons – the Opera House, see the spectacular views the Gap at Watson’s Bay has to offer and stop at one of Australia’s most famous beaches, Bondi Beach. During your visit at the Opera House, officially opened by Queen Elizabeth II on October 20, 1973, enjoy a guided tour of this iconic building with its distinctive sail-like roof while learning about its history, design and current role.

A brief stop will be made at the Gap at Watson's Bay, the South Head of the entrance to Sydney Harbor. The spectacular views across the gap between the North and South Heads make for some memorable photos Enjoy a photo stop at Bondi Beach, Australia's world famous surfing beach where both Sydneysiders and tourists alike each come to enjoy the half-mile crescent of sandy beach and the delightful eateries and shops which line the main street.

Note: Tour involves a considerable walking and approximately 200 steps to negotiate at the Opera House. Photography is not permitted inside the Opera House.

Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
