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Otago Harbor Wildlife Cruise - DD18

A specially designed 60-foot boat and its knowledgeable captain and crew make this excursion infinitely enjoyable and interesting. You will marvel at the sights around you as you travel through Otago Harbour – one of New Zealand's best spots to view albatrosses, seals, cormorants and other sea birds.
